## **Free Cavity Prevention for Kids, a Visit from Santa, & Holiday Crafts**

To aid in preventing tooth decay in young children, Southeastern Idaho Public Health will be holding their 3<sup>rd</sup> annual fluoride varnish clinic with a visit from Santa. This event is for children of all ages at their Bannock County Office located at 1901 Alvin Ricken Drive on Monday, December 18<sup>th</sup> from 2:00-5:00pm. A dental screening, fluoride varnish (a non-invasive dental treatment that helps prevent tooth decay) will be offered along with a visit from Santa and holiday crafts. Fluoride is covered by most insurance plans; please bring your insurance card with you to the clinic. If you do not have health insurance, or are “underinsured,” the cost of the fluoride application is by donation only, but no one will be denied services due to inability to pay.
