Southeastern Idaho Public Health to hold Grand Reopening

Southeastern Idaho Public Health (SIPH) would like to invite the public to their grand reopening of the Franklin County office at 42 West 1st South Street in Preston. There will be an open house on Friday, February 24th from 11:00 am-1:00 pm that is open to the public.

SIPH offers a variety of services by local professionals from the community. The WIC program assists families and pregnant women with increasing nutritional education and provides financial assistance with nutritional daily requirements. To qualify for WIC services, call or stop in to see if you meet the income and family size guidelines. WIC also covers pregnant women to assist in having healthy outcomes with pregnancy.

Clinical services offered include annual exams, birth control, child and adult immunizations, travel vaccines, and male and female STD related services. We offer education to the public about planning pregnancies, and healthy pregnancies in conjunction with the WIC program. Clinical service staff also works in the local schools to provide vital screenings, education, and immunizations to school aged children and adolescents.

SIPH also provides Environmental services to the Franklin County area. Environmental services include food permits, restaurant inspections, septic permits, and conducts childcare inspections. .

The Franklin County SIPH office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm to meet the needs of the public. The public is welcome to attend the open house on Friday, February 24th, to see our new facility, obtain education, or meet the staff.
