This discussion focused on the gaps of youth substance use and mental health treatment within the American Falls area. Stace Gearhart added a main takeaway from this meeting was about the use of building to streamline community resources. Angie Harker informed the committee this building has the following services already running: GED program with ISU, Community council does high school equivalency, migrant council, refer to resources, Dept. of Labor there one day weekly and TRIO. Questions of Telehealth did get raised through this discussion. Kyle Hanson and Stace Gearhart reported on that the Ghostly Gatherings Event went very well. The approximated attendance was 4,000 people. The Region VI Behavioral Health Board and Children's Mental Health Committee was represented by a new banner and literature was handed out.
