Review / Approval of Past Minutes			
All Members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meeting minutes for 5.19.2020 were disseminated by email to all committee members for review prior to meeting. Stace Gearhart made motion to approved meeting minutes as written; Kyle Hanson seconded the motion. Motioned passed unanimously; minutes approved by committee.</li> </ul>		
Committee Member Announcements			
All Members	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stace reports that IDJC state has had their 1<sup>st</sup> cases in juvenile detention centers. There were six adults that tested positive in the Nampa facility, and there are two cottages in St. Anthony that are self-isolating but have not gotten test results back yet. He also brought discussion topics of the schools reopening and the need to educate compromised / vulnerable adults about telehealth has an option. He also shared the link to the Juvenile Justice Family Handbook with the committee members.</li> <li>Kyle also shared concern for uncertainty of school reopening this fall. There will be a new community resource person in place. They are working on the new mobile crisis system, which will help those in crisis and delay emergency room visits for mental health crisis. Kyle will report more on this as this system is developed further.</li> <li>Suzanne from Optum discussed that new criteria that is out for DD services. With this change in criteria it opens more children being eligible for DD services, it also shows that more DD service providers are needed. She suggested some education of the new criteria to be done with the CMH committee.</li> <li>Maria with the P.A.T. program reports that although there are no in-home visits happening at this time, they are meeting with the families telephonically or through a virtual meeting platform. The program is looking at doing group connections virtually.</li> <li>Kim reported that the school district has released the return plan, as long the situation doesn't escalate in our area District #25 plans on children back in school. District #25 return plan can be viewed on there website, the link was shared with members.</li> <li>Brad Baker announced there was federal money received from FEMA. With these emergency funds there is funding for supportive services for first responders, some funding for emergency diversion if needed. Grant monies for outreach services to notify community of resources out. There will be a position established for resource referral source. We need to remember that that with COVID-19, it is a longer term than first anticipated.</li> </ul>
