Report Review		
Discussion	<p>The strategic plan document was finalized. We created timelines and action plans based on the gaps and need document.</p> <p>Housing – Please bring all information regarding housing to the April meeting. We want to have a list of resources available to make into a resource card by that time. Any resources regarding anything to do with housing for families in Region 6. We would like to be able to format these resources into card to be able to hand out at the May workshop.</p> <p>Transportation – MTM has released a guide that has contact information. There is also a parental consent form for children to be able to ride transportation without an adult present. MTM is asking providers to give information on who is receiving transportation services and what those services are.</p> <p>Access to Care Continuum – Melissa Scott is the YES program expert. Most of the information is available now, but the details haven't been set yet. We would like to set up meetings in the outlying counties and go out as a team and answer questions. Not all providers have even heard of the YES program.</p> <p>Collaboration of school districts - We would like to provide more parent education support. We would like to educate on how to access respite care. We could possibly sponsor a mental health first aide training. This has proven to be good information for frontline staff and others who are in rural communities that don't have access to crisis response.</p>
