Jason Mackrill	<p>“Mack” is currently a deputy prosecutor in Bannock county, he identified a need and is helping to implement a program called Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM). This program was designed close to 30 years ago to help 1st responders with the onset of PTSD after responding / experiencing a traumatic event. The 1st training for the volunteers happened earlier this month, where approximately 80 CISM peers were trained to respond as a</p>		

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	<p>“debrief response for 1st responders. Volunteers are not all licensed but trained to intervene after traumatic events.</p> <p>Mack asked for private counselors that may carve out the time for being able to prioritize those that may have a need for acute care after CISM interventions.
