Southeastern Idaho Public Health offers free HIV, Hepatitis C, and Syphilis screening for the month of March

Southeastern Idaho Public Health is offering free rapid HIV, syphilis, and hepatitis C testing for at-risk people for the entire month of March in each of our 8 county offices.

If you or someone you care about has risk, get tested free at Southeastern Idaho Public Health this March! Testing is confidential and only takes a few minutes to get results.

The CDC recommends screening for Hepatitis C if you...

- were born between 1945 and 1965, if you have never been tested
- have ever received an unregulated tattoo
- have ever injected illicit drugs
- received a blood transfusion prior to 1992

People from all backgrounds get HIV, Hepatitis C, and Syphilis. Getting infected has nothing to do with who you are, and everything to do with what you do. You should get tested if you...

- have had sex without a condom with more than one person
- use needles to inject drugs
- have ever been infected with an STD
