Southeastern Idaho Public Health Reduces COVID-19 Hotline Operation Hours

SOUTHEAST IDAHO- Southeastern Idaho Public Health (SIPH) will be reducing their COVID-19 hotline hours to 9 am-4:30 pm starting on Monday, May 4. The hotline was established on March 13th after the first case of COVID-19 was identified in Idaho. The hotline has answered over 1,200 calls since it began on March 16th.

We appreciate the call center staff who have assisted with answering the calls.” said Maggie Mann, SIPH District Director. “We want to make sure the public has plenty of access to accurate and factual information so they can continue to take steps to protect their family from getting sick.”
