## **Due to Extreme Weather in the US Southeastern Idaho Public Health Will Not Be Receiving this Week's Vaccine Allocation**

Southeastern Idaho Public Health just received notification that this week's vaccine shipment is delayed due to the extreme weather across the US. Because of this, Southeastern Idaho Public Health must cancel appointments that were scheduled at the Sports and Orthopedic Center on the ISU Campus for February 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup>. Once Southeastern Idaho Public Health receives notification that vaccine is on its way, SIPH will contact individuals to reschedule their appointments.

All vaccine providers in southeast Idaho are being impacted by the weather delay, so please do not expect to schedule a vaccine appointment with another provider. For people who were scheduled to receive their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose, they have up to 6 weeks, or 42 days, to receive that 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. Southeastern Idaho Public Health will do everything possible to ensure this timeline is met.
