Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of November 9 – November 15, 2021, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 402 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 26,392. Out of the 26,392 cases, 25,537 have recovered from COVID-19. There were also 6 confirmed deaths, which brings the total to 405 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
