Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of January 11-January 18, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 2224 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 31,066. Out of the 31,066 cases, 28,185 have recovered from COVID-19.

There was also one confirmed death, which brings the total to 456 deaths due to COVID-19. Out of respect to the individual’s family, no additional details will be released.
