Southeastern Idaho Public Health's Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of July 5-11, 2022 Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 374 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 39,708. Out of the 39,708 cases, 38,857 have recovered from COVID-19. There was also one confirmed death, which brings the total to 523 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals' families, no additional details will be released.
