Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of June 14-June 20, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 154 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 38,828. Out of the 38,828 cases, 38,010 have recovered from COVID-19.
