Southeastern Idaho Public Health’s Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of September 20 – September 26, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 149 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 41,916. Out of the 41,916 cases, 41,204 have recovered from COVID-19. There are 1 confirmed death, which brings the total to 549 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals’ families, no additional details will be released.
