Southeastern Idaho Public Health's Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of August 30-September 5, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 110 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 41,465. Out of the 41,465 cases, 40,693 have recovered from COVID-19. There were no confirmed deaths for this week, which keeps the total at 543 deaths.
