Southeastern Idaho Public Health's Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of September 6-12, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 163 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 41,630. Out of the 41,630 cases, 40,923 have recovered from COVID-19. There were three confirmed deaths for this week, which keeps the total at 546 deaths, due to COVID-19. Out of respect to these individuals' families, no additional details will be released.
