Southeastern Idaho Public Health's Weekly COVID-19 Update

For the week of September 13-19, 2022, Southeastern Idaho Public Health had 134 new confirmed and probable cases of COVID-19. This brings the total of confirmed and probable cases to 41,764. Out of the 41,764 cases, 41,025 have recovered from COVID-19. There were two confirmed deaths due to COVID-19 for this week, which brings the total to 548 deaths. Out of respect to these individuals' families, no additional details will be released.
